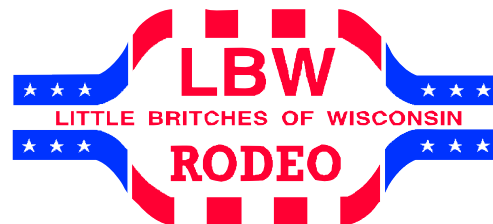


# April '08 Newsletter

## **OLD BUSINESS**

Trailer-The drop deck trailer has the steel on it. Some adjustments need to be made yet.

Rodeo Dates-May 31 & June 1 will not have a rodeo. Aug. 23 & 24 we will have a rodeo in Dallas, WI at the Triple HHH Equestrian Center. They are very eager to have us there. The stock will be used at the Medford High School Rodeo again this year.

Rulebooks-500 printed, every family will get a new rulebook. If you want an extra they are \$1.00 each. Judges will get a thank you for last year and new rule book for this year.

Backtags-They are almost done. Contestants will get two laminated backtag numbers to use. Numbers will not be handed out at the meetings. Contestants will be responsible for their own backtags and having them at each rodeo.

Clinic-The instructors are almost all set. Hoping for a big turnout in Holmen April 26 & 27 for the rough stock/timed event clinic.

Needed items-The decision was made to order new pads for the roping box, new roping barriers, and new pole bases.

Check-in time-11 a.m. will still be check-in time but the meeting time will now be at 11:15 a.m. This will allow the contestant/parent (one parent must attend) meeting to get done sooner to give the contestant time to get warmed up prior to the rodeo start.

Student directors-Dena Johnson and Pam Shaw will be the student directors.
