Old Business:

Sponsor (Town) Contracts: Contracts were updated and sent out to the towns who wish to have a rodeo this year. The deadline for turning in contracts is Feb.15, 2006.

Gate Trailer: Kevin Einerson put a new lift on jack (thanks much Kevin). More welding needs to be done on gates and chutes...it was agreed that LBW will pay Kevin to do the welding for us. Once the welding is done, Greg and Gary will put a team together to break everything done, and load it up.

There will be a workday Feb. 18 to set up the pens so Kevin can weld.

New Business:
